Registration and Fees

For the past two seasons there has been a reduced rate for registration fees. There has been an increase in ice cost, and a reduced participation in fundraising initiatives. For these reasons, the executive will be reviewing the registration fees and fee schedules for payment. These changes will be available for review prior to registration deadlines.
